- Tournament is non-ranking (no Tennis BC points awarded) and is limited to 100 participants (50 doubles teams) on a "first come first serve" basis.
- A single person can enter up to two events.

Play

- All matches will be played only at the New Westminster Tennis Club
- All matches are to be governed by the Rules of Tennis, and players are expected to abide by the Code of Conduct as set out by both ITF and Tennis Canada
- Matches will be the best of three tie-break sets. Alternate formats may be used in order to complete events within the scheduled time frame. Matches may be played under lights.
- All players are expected to participate in any consolation draw, as this is considered to be an extension of the main draw.
- A Maximum of ten (10) minutes warm-up will be enforced.
- All decision of the Tournament Referee and/or Tournament Director and/or Tournament Committee will be final.

Scheduling

- Players will be expected to play when scheduled. Lateness penalties, including default after 15 minutes, may be enforced.
- Hours of play are 6:00pm-11pm on May 18 – May 21 and 9:00am – 11:00pm on May 22-24.
- **Due to the short span of the tournament and limited number of courts, all registered players must be available to play each and every day from May 18 to May 24.**
- All players are responsible to check the tournament website for any weather or scheduling changes that may occur up to 4 hours before the scheduled time of play.

Play

- All matches will be played only at the New Westminster Tennis Club
- All matches are to be governed by the Rules of Tennis, and players are expected to abide by the Code of Conduct as set out by both ITF and Tennis Canada
- Matches will be the best of three tie-break sets. Alternate formats may be used in order to complete events within the scheduled time frame. Matches may be played under lights.
- All players are expected to participate in any consolation draw, as this is considered to be an extension of the main draw.
- A Maximum of ten (10) minutes warm-up will be enforced.
- All decision of the Tournament Referee and/or Tournament Director and/or Tournament Committee will be final.

Scheduling

- Players will be expected to play when scheduled. Lateness penalties, including default after 15 minutes, may be enforced.
- Hours of play are 6:00pm-11pm on May 18 – May 21 and 9:00am – 11:00pm on May 22-24.
- **Due to the short span of the tournament and limited number of courts, all registered players must be available to play each and every day from May 18 to May24.**
- All players are responsible to check the tournament website for any weather or scheduling changes that may occur up to 4 hours before the scheduled time of play.

Refund Policy and Waiver of Claims

- Refunds will not be issued once the draw has been made.
- A \$10 admin fee applies to any refunds granted beforehand.
